Exercise : Working as an operator

This exercise requires loading the IGSS Demo configuration.

If you have IGSS Free50 installed, you must switch license file as follows:

1. Close all IGSS programs.
2. Go to the [IGSS InstallPath]\Gss and rename the license file Options.txt to Options_original.txt.
3. In the same folder, rename the file Options.DEMO to Options.txt. (When IGSS is online, it always uses the license file called Options.txt)
4. The Demo license is now active for your system.
(If you need to go back to Free50, reverse the naming procedure described above.)
5. In System Configuration, open the **File** menu and choose **Open Demo Configuration**.
